RTS Plus ADA Compliance and Public Accommodations

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is a federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination against people with disabilities. Under this law, people with disabilities are entitled to all of the rights, privileges, advantages, and opportunities that others have when participating in public programs and activities and when using public services and facilities.

The City of Gainesville adheres to the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and will make reasonable accommodations for access to City buildings, services, programs, and activities.

The City of Gainesville does not discriminate on the basis of a disability in its programs, activities or services. An ADA Coordinator (City's Equal Opportunity Director) has been designated to coordinate compliance with non-discrimination requirements contained in the Department of Justice regulations implementing Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

How to get ADA Certified

Schedule a Ride with RTS plus Paratransit Service

You have choices:

1. Call RTS Plus at (352) 393-(RIDE)7433 to set up your travel reservation. From 8 a.m.-5 p.m.
2. Use the RTSplus app and you can schedule your ride as late as to 11:59 p.m. the day before and up to 14 days in advance. You can also pay and track your ride via the app. To download the app go to the apple store or Andriod Play store to download the RTSplus.app You can use the QR codes to direct you to get the RTS plus app also pay and track your ride via the website.
3. Use our Website <https://rtsplus.app.ridewithvia.com> you can schedule your ride as late as to 11:59 p.m. the day before and up to 14 days in advance. You can also pay and track your ride via the website.

Scheduling Hours of Operation*

- **Weekday Service:** Starts 6 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- **Saturday Service:** Starts at 7 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- **Sunday Service:** Starts at 10 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

* Consecutive trips must be scheduled a minimum of sixty (60) minutes apart

* No same day bookings accepted.

Service Fee Payment Methods:

The fee remains \$3.00 per trip with an option to pay via the RTSplus app or with exact fare on the vehicle (Farebox does not provide change).

Fixed Route Service

ADA certified individuals can ride any RTS fixed-route service for free with your valid ADA card.

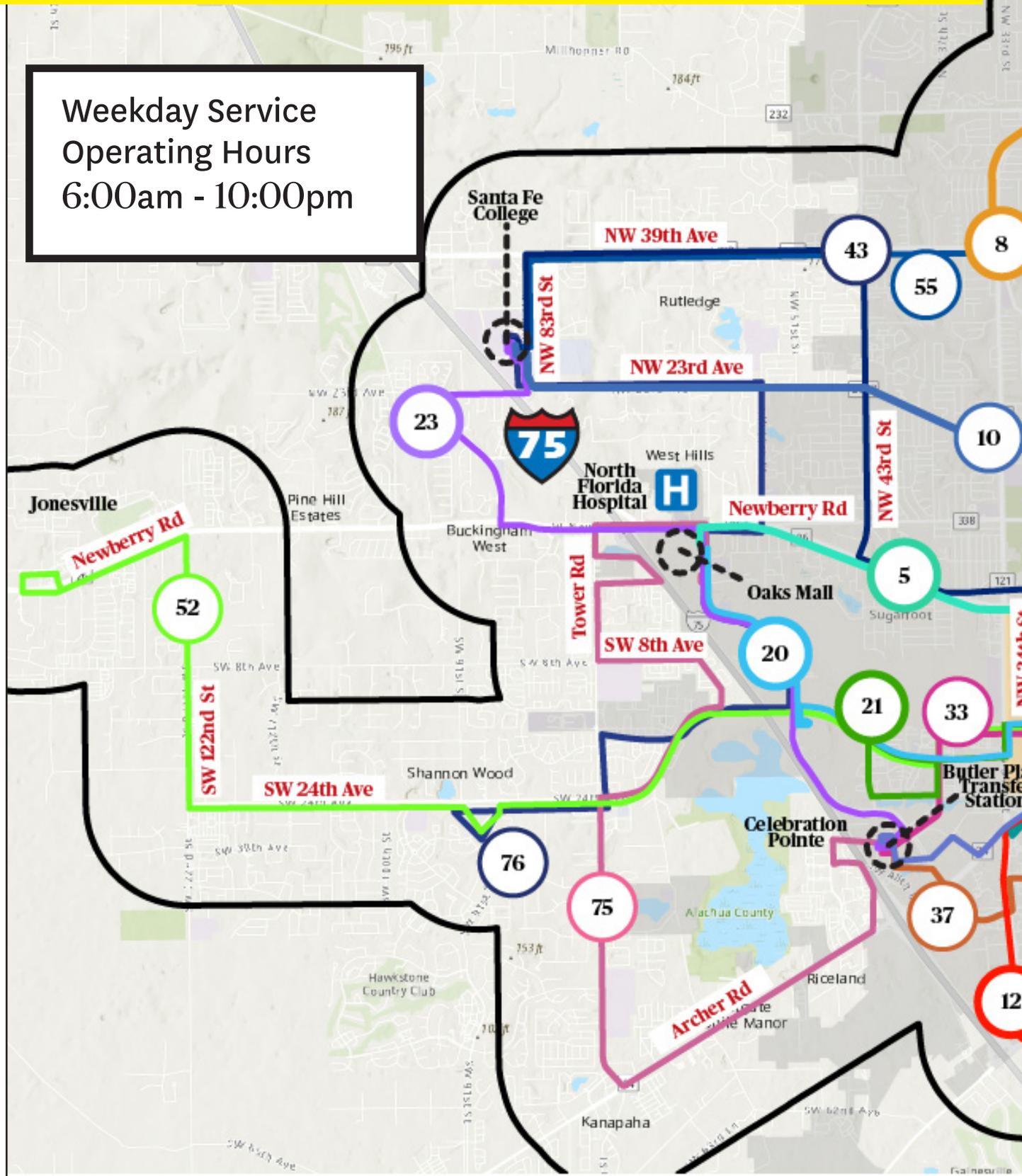

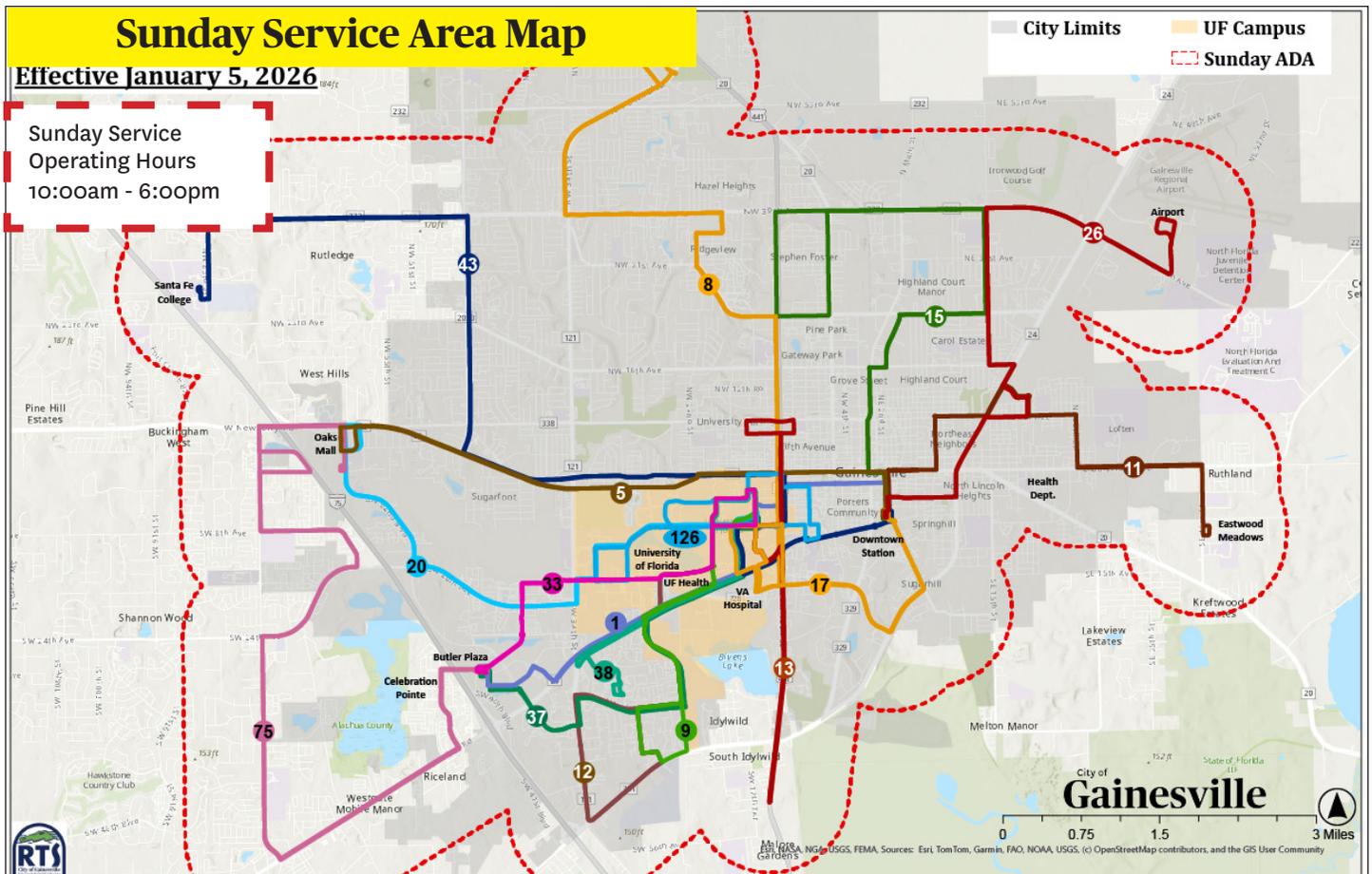
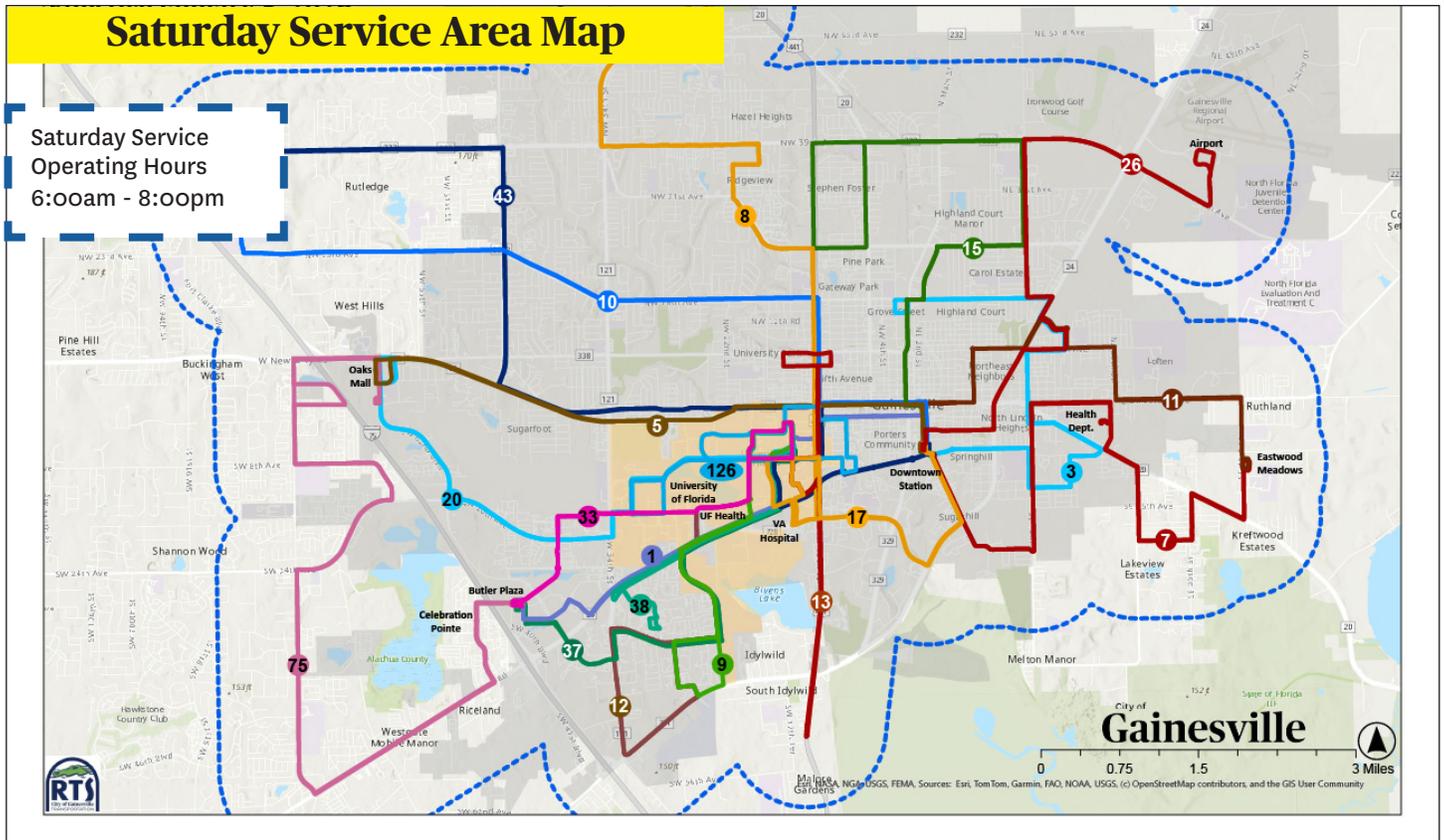
Weekday Service Area Map

RTS Connect Service “Mobility on Demand”

Route 600: “Mobility on Demand” transit service offers free transportation to East Gainesville

Riders in East Gainesville can call the city’s Regional Transit System (RTS) “Mobility on Demand” (MOD) service for free transportation to clinic visits, health screenings and other essential community resources. The shuttles go door-to-door for passengers who can’t walk to an RTS bus stop or need additional support to reach their destinations reliably and affordably.

- Cone Park Branch of the Alachua County Library

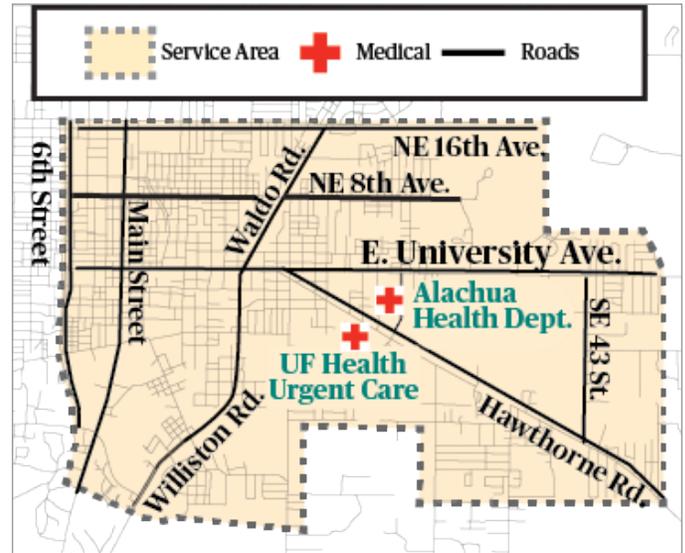
