Frequently Asked Questions

RTSPlus ADA Services:

Our commitment to the community is making RTS rides available and accessible to everyone, including those with disabilities. ADA certified individuals can ride any RTS fixed-route service for free with a valid ADA card.

RTSPlus also offers complementary door-to-door paratransit service in lift-equipped vehicles for those ADA paratransit certified riders who are unable to use the fixed-route service.

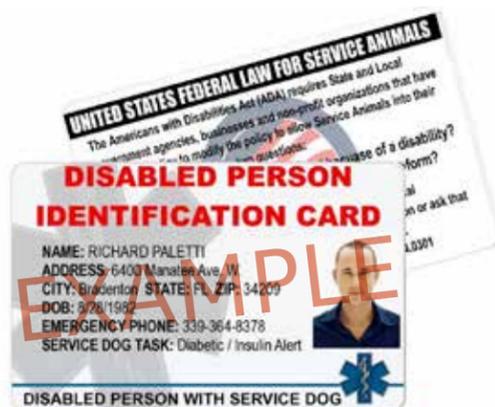
RTS Public Transit Mission:

To enhance the quality of life in our community by providing safe, courteous, equitable, reliable and energy-efficient transportation services.

How to Get ADA Certified:

To become ADA certified, potential applicants need to contact the Center for Independent Living of North Central Florida (CILNCF) to schedule an ADA Paratransit Screening.

The CILNCF is located at **222 SW 36th Terrace, Gainesville, FL 32607** which is on the RTS Route 5 standard bus route. For more information, contact ADA Paratransit Coordinator Myrtle Hoffman at **(352) 378-7474** or visit their website <https://www.cilnfc.org>.



How do I schedule a ride with RTSPlus?

1. Through the RTSPlus App:

Use the RTSPlus app, found in the Android and Google Play stores, or use the QR codes below.

3. Call RTSPlus:

You can call **(352) 393-7433** to set up your travel reservation. 8a.m. to 4p.m. 7 days a week.

When can I schedule a ride?

RTSPlus Hours for Scheduling By Phone*:

- Monday - Sunday: Starts 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

You can schedule a ride as late as 11:59 p.m. the day before, and up to 14 days in advance.

- * Consecutive trips must be scheduled at least sixty (60) minutes apart.
- * No same-day bookings accepted.

How much does a ride cost?

The charge per ride on RTSPlus remains \$3.00 per trip.

How do I pay for a ride?

Fares can be paid in advance within the RTSPlus app, or at the farebox using **exact fare only*** when you board the vehicle.

NOTE: * RTSPlus drivers do not make change.

What should I do when the vehicle arrives?

Riders should be ready at least 15 minutes before you scheduled pick-up time.

The RTSPlus service will send you a phone notification for when your driver is about to arrive. The driver will knock on your door to let you know they are ready to pick you up. Be sure to be ready for the driver to make it to your destination in time.

What if I need to cancel a ride?

There are two options for canceling a ride:

1. You can cancel a ride using the RTSPlus app.

2. Call RTSPlus and cancel a ride with customer service.

RTSPlus hours of operation:

- Weekday Service: Starts 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Saturday Service: Starts at 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Sunday Service: Starts at 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

We put together a few steps to help get you on board.

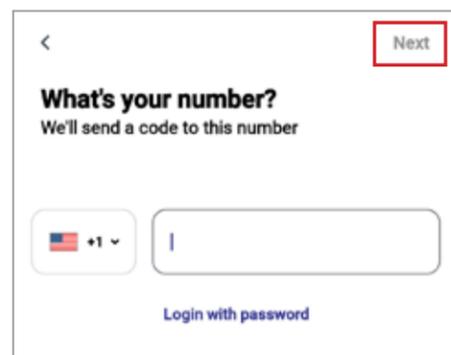
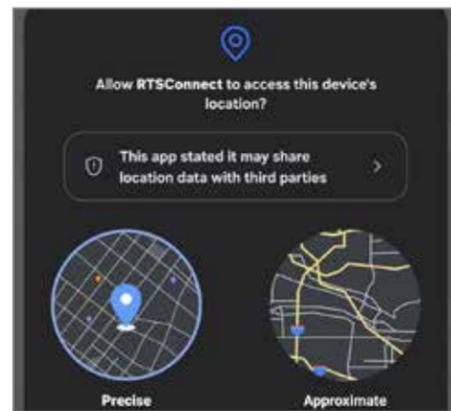

Step 1. How to download the App:

Use the QR code below, or search RTSPlus in the Apple or Google Play Store.

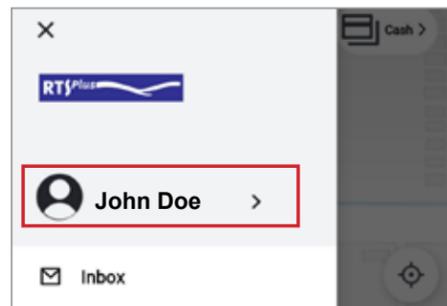
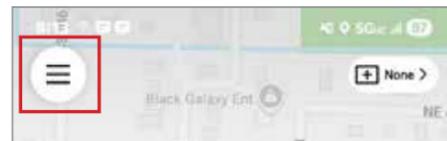
If prompted, allow **location access**. Then create an account with a phone number and the verification code you receive. Then select **Next** at top right.



Step 2. Set your payment type:

You may need to set your **Payment Type** before attempting to schedule a ride. Otherwise, your ride may be invalid. Go to the **Rider Menu** located at the top left of your screen.

Select your **Account Name**. Go to **Payment Methods**. Add your preferred payment option, if applicable.

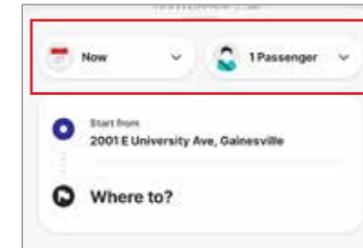


NOTE: You do not need a user name and password at this time to edit your payment methods.
You can create a user name and password as an alternative way to log into the app.

Step 3. Set your service type, date, arrive by time & number of riders:

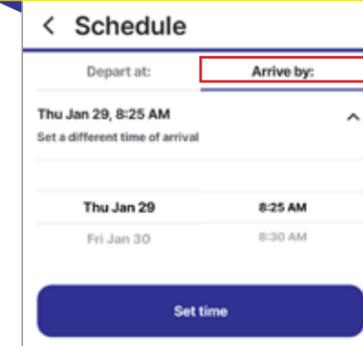
Select **Date**, **Arrival By** and **how many passengers** will be traveling.

You can request a ride during service hours the day before (for ADA, before 11:59pm), or you can book a ride up to 14 days in advance.



NOTE: Be sure to select your Payment Type BEFORE you attempt to set an appointment arrival time.

NOTE: Set arrival time at least 15 minutes before actual appointment time.



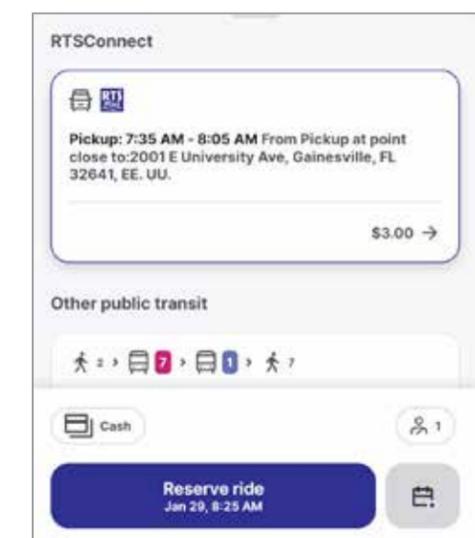
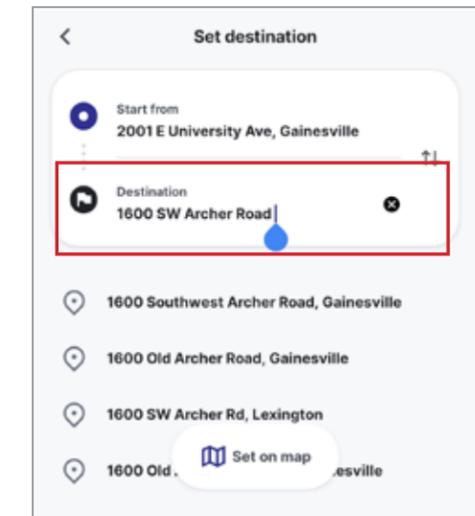
NOTE: An arrival of 15 minutes before your actual appointment gives you time to exit the Vehicle to take any stairs, elevators, walkways, etc. to get to your appointment on time.

Step 4. Set your destination:

In the **Start From** section, enter the specific address of your pick-up location.

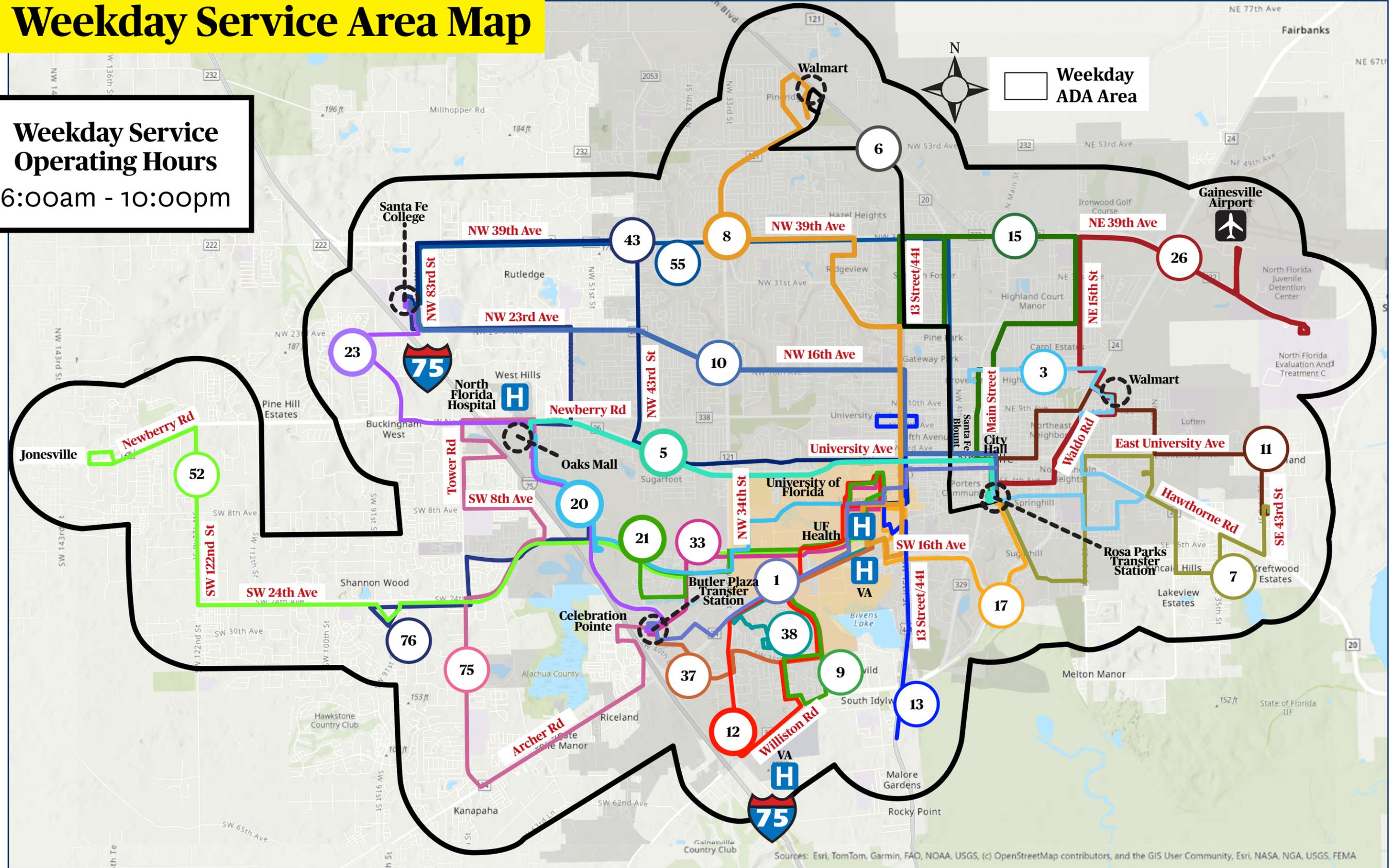
NOTE: Do not rely on the Current Location option that may auto-fill in the **Start From** section as the GPS may not be accurate. In the **Where to** section, enter the specific address or your drop-off location.



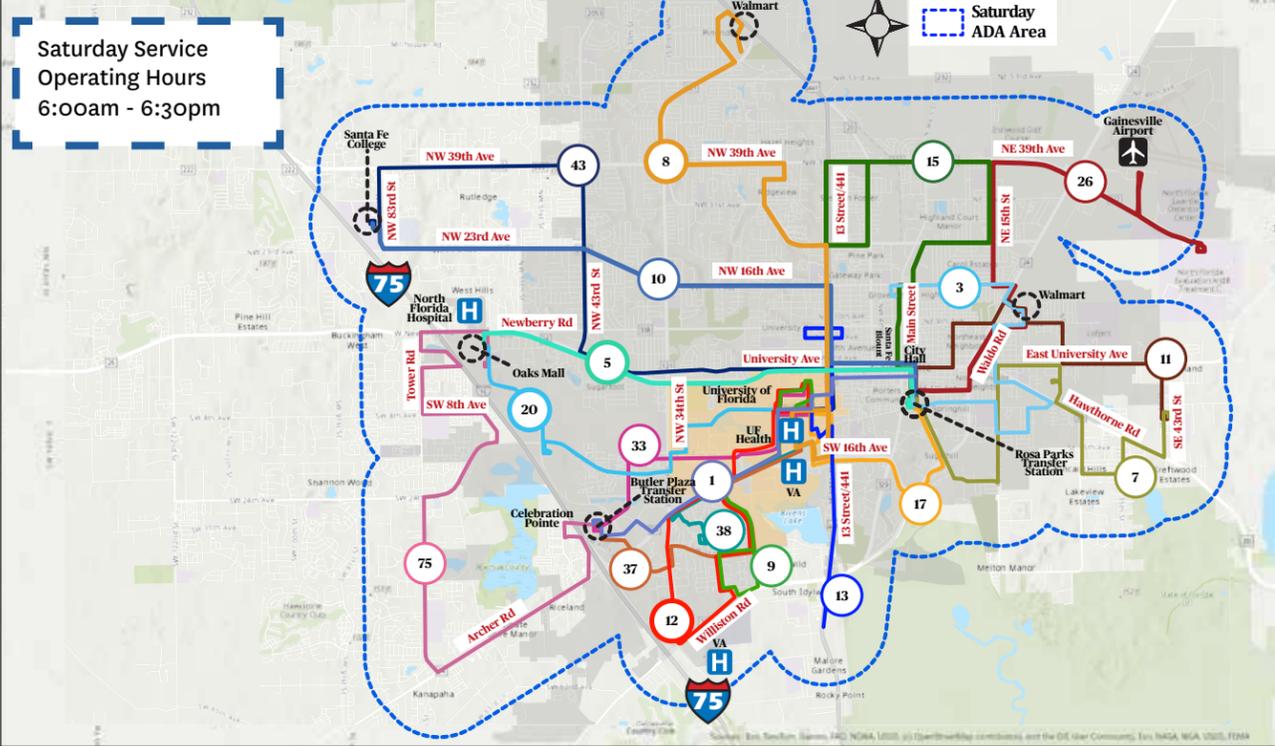

Weekday Service Area Map

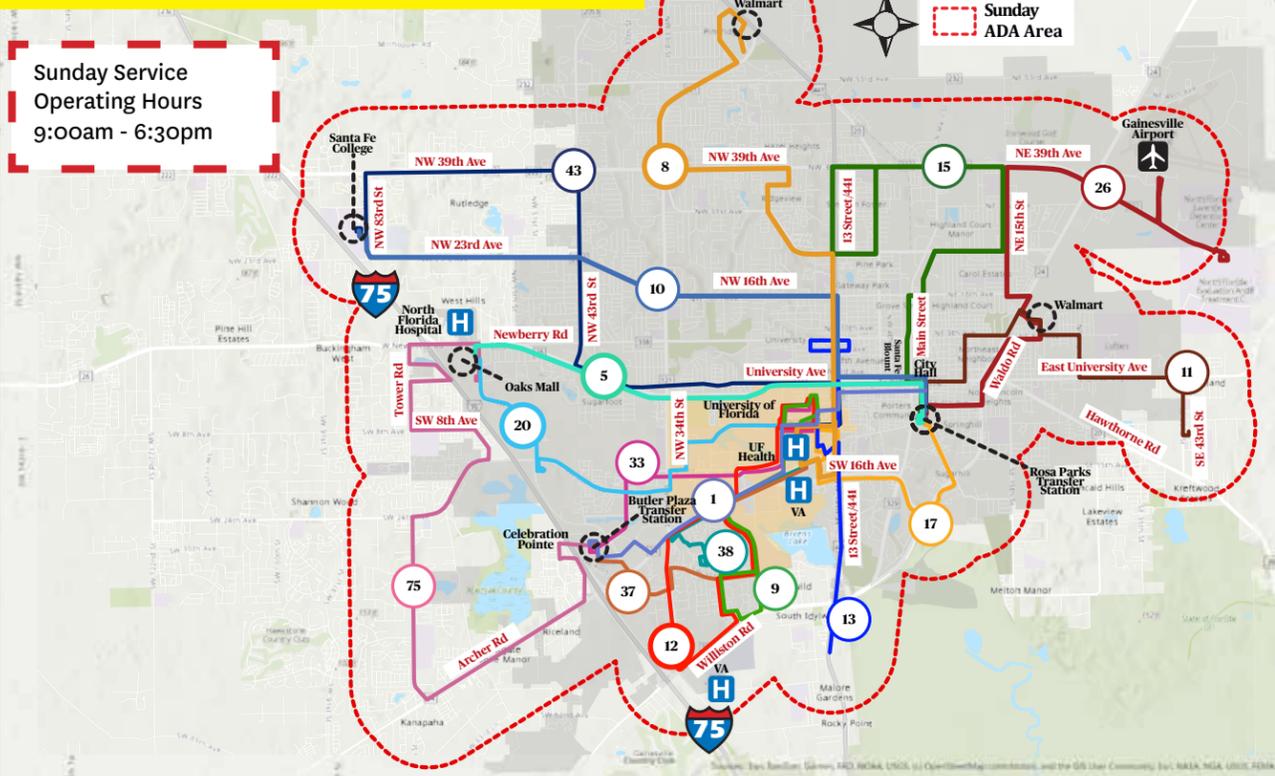
Weekday Service Operating Hours

Sunday Service Area Map



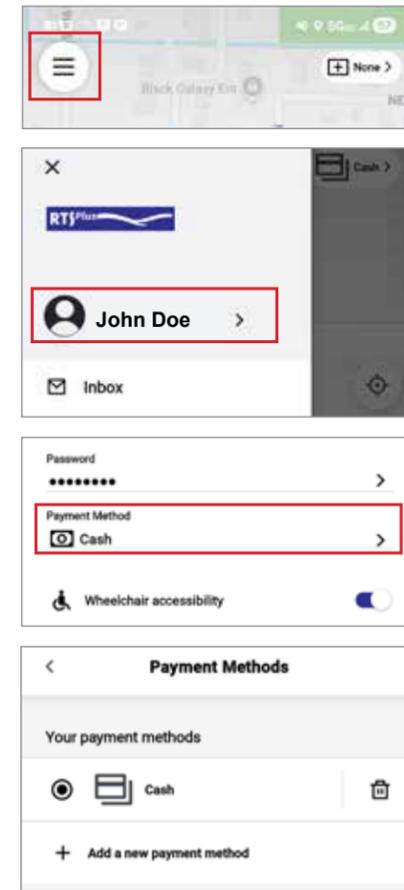
Additional App Information.

How to set payment, see your scheduled rides, and edit and cancel a ride.

Payment Type:

You can pay for your rides with exact fare in cash on the bus or with a debit/credit card on the RTSPlus app.

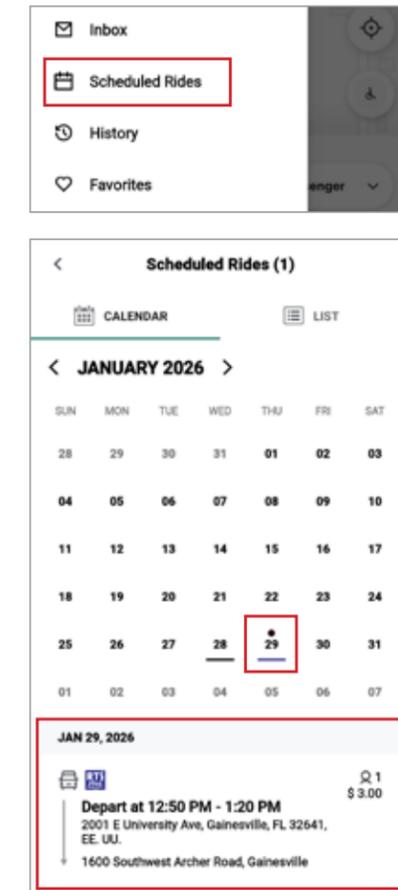
Go to the **Rider Menu**, click on your account name, go to **Payment Methods**, and add your preferred option, if applicable.



View Scheduled Rides:

You can also see all scheduled rides from the **Rider Menu**.

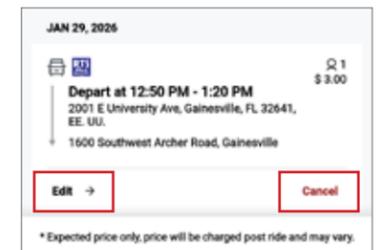
Select **Scheduled Rides** to access the calendar or list view of your future rides.



Edit or Cancel a Ride:

To edit or cancel a scheduled ride, go to the **Rider Menu** and select **Scheduled Rides**. Select the ride you want to edit or cancel, and then select **Edit** to change the date or time, or select **Cancel** to cancel the ride.

Cancellations are possible **up to 30 minutes before** your actual appointment time.



REMINDER: Arrival should be at least 15 minutes before actual appointment time.



More Info

Setting Arrival By time:

As the Depart tab is shown first by default, you will need to select the **Arrival By** tab.

It's good practice to use a preferred **Arrival By** time with an **arrival of 15 minutes before your actual appointment**. This method gives you buffer time to exit the transport vehicle and take any stairs, elevators, walkways, etc. to get to your appointment on time.

Select your **Date**, and then **Arrival By** time.

You will be given a selection of arrival times for your appointment. Select the option that best fits your needs.

Note: Depart time is better for when you want to be picked up at a specific time but do not need a specific arrival time. For example, you need transport after attending an event and you are ready to go back home.

RTS Mobility on Demand:

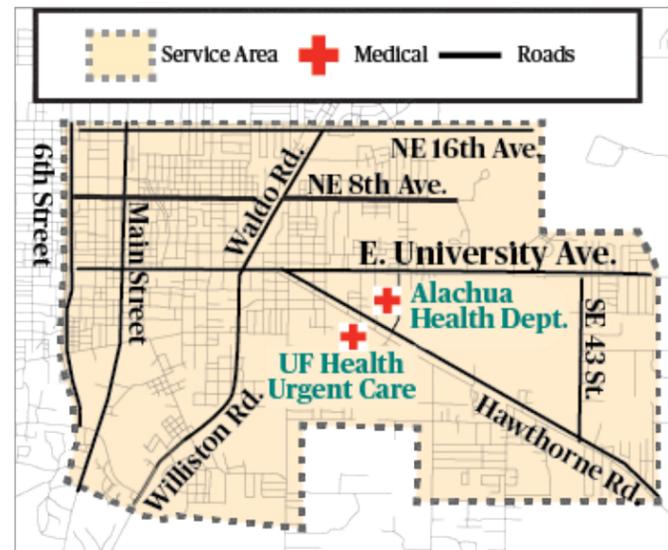
Riders in East Gainesville can call the city's Regional Transit System (RTS) "Mobility on Demand" (MOD) service for free transportation to clinic visits, health screenings and other essential community resources. The shuttles go door-to-door for passengers who can't walk to an RTS bus stop or need additional support to reach their destinations reliably and affordably.

Serviced locations include

- UF Health Urgent Care Center – Eastside
- Florida Department of Health in Alachua County
- Partnership for Strong Families Family Resource Center
- Cone Park Branch of the Alachua County Library

Hours of Operation

- **Mon -Fri:** Frequency 30-60 min.
 - Morning Service: 5:45 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.
 - Afternoon Service: 3:45 p.m. – 7:15 p.m.
- **Sat:** No Service
- **Sun:** No Service

RTS Standard Route Service:

ADA certified individuals can ride any RTS fixed-route service for free with your valid ADA card. Go to go-rts.com to use our trip planner. Below are instructions to download the app to track your bus.

Bus Predictions Assistant.

Text **(844) 899-1556** and enter your bus ID number and receive a list of arrival times for routes that service your stop.



GNVRideRTS (mobile) and www.RideRTS.app (desktop).

Track your bus in real time, find nearby stops, find routes and plan your trip. Save your favorite bus stop(s), subscribe to rider alerts and service detours, and set up text message alerts so you know when your bus is due to arrive.



Service outside of the RTS Area:

The RTSPPlus service area is defined by the RTS fixed-route Bus service area. For trips which begin or end outside of the RTSPPlus service area, especially for dialysis and other medically necessary trips, your trip may be eligible to be covered by one of the following services which are operated on behalf of Alachua County by MV Transportation. For more information or to book a trip, please call MV Transportation at (352) 375-2784.

**Transportation Disadvantaged Program (TD): these funds are allocated according to need. TD sponsors medical trips such as dialysis appointments which begin or end outside RTSPPlus service areas and times.*

**5311 Rural Rides Program: this is a County-Federal partnership which subsidizes trips on a first come, first serve basis which serve areas designated as rural by the US Census bureau.*

- Transportation Disadvantaged (or TD) Program: Rural transportation provided
- 5311 Rural Transportation: Trips throughout Alachua County
- Vocational Services
- Foster Grandparents
- Elder Care and the RSVP Program

RTSPPlus ADA Statement:

The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) is a federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination against people living with disabilities.

Pets:

Service animals are allowed at emergency shelters.

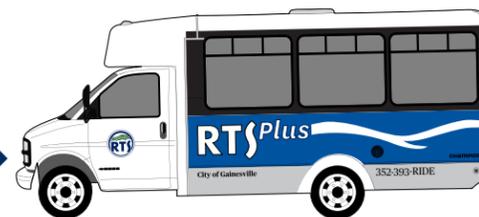
You will receive time-sensitive messages wherever you specify, such as your home, mobile or business phones, email address, text messages and more.
